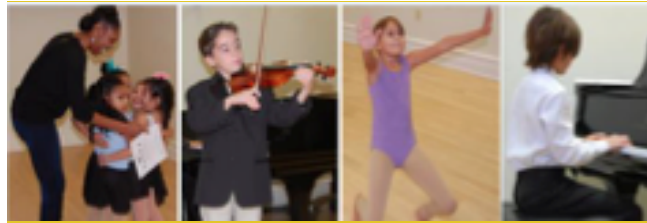


About Newark School Of The Arts

I.C.A.N. PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION

The Newark School of the Arts (NSA) provides an exclusive arts program for Newark Public and Private School students.

Funding from several sources allow introductory discount rates for first-time students residing in Newark to enroll in private lessons in music, or group lessons in drama, dance, and visual arts.

School principals, administrators and/or classroom teachers are encouraged to identify students who love the arts to apply for the I.C.A.N. Program. Students must commit to a 17-week semester. **Parents/Guardians are required to complete the application form, obtain school signature from principal, teacher or administrator and provide proof of income (MOST RECENT 1040 Income tax form, W2). Applications will not be accepted without the supporting proof of income documentation. PROOF OF ADDRESS: current water or electricity/gas bill or any government letter**

The I.C.A.N. Program provides a 40% discount off of regular rates for one semester for:

- Private lessons in music, including theory class at no additional charge at \$367.20 for 16 weeks.
- Group lessons in visual arts, dance and drama at \$183.00 for 16 weeks.
- Annual Family Registration fee of \$65.00

Fees must be paid in full at time of registration. No refunds.
